

# Bible Drill & Speakers' Tournament State Finals

## Registration Instructions

The registration process for the State Finals will be similar to the process for regional events. While there will be enough drills to accommodate all participants, drill times will be chosen on a first come, first served basis. Registration will open at 8:30 pm on Tuesday, April 30 and will close at noon on Wednesday, May 1, or when all participants have registered. After that time, registration will be closed and groups will no longer be able to register. Please read the instructions below carefully so that you will be able to register your group. Please note that most spaces were filled within 15 minutes of registration opening last year, so make every effort to enter at 8:30 p.m. to register for your preferred space.

On Tuesday, April 30, you will receive an email with the link to register your group. This link will also be available on the Bible Drill website, [texasbaptists.org/bibledrill](http://texasbaptists.org/bibledrill). This link will not be live until 8:30 p.m. At 8:30 p.m., you may click on the link to begin the registration process.

Once again, while there will be enough drills to accommodate all participants, drill times will be on a first come, first served basis. Once a drill is full, it will be grayed out and no changes can be made. **There will be no changes once registration is closed.**

The following information will be needed to complete the process: Sponsors/parents' first and last names, sponsors/parents' email addresses, sponsors/parents' mobile phone numbers and providers, church name, church city, participant's first and last name, participant's grade, participant's email address, cell phone number and provider version of the Bible using, and whether the participant has competed for three consecutive years in their division.

### Step One

First, you will register as a sponsor/parent for your participant(s). Fill out your information, including cell phone number and provider, which will allow us to text you in case of an emergency during the drill.

## Step Six

Once all of your participants have been entered for an age group, click on “Continue” (blue button). Your drill times will not be finalized until you click “Continue” for each age group. You will be redirected to the age group selection screen. You will repeat steps 2-5 until all of your participants have been registered.

## Other Information

After registration closes on May 1 at noon, you will receive an email with room numbers and other important information about your drill. Please read this information closely.

**Because you will be choosing your drill time when you register, no changes will be made after registration closes.**

**Participants will be responsible for bringing their own Bibles for state drills. Bible do not have to be new, but should be free of any markings, folded pages, tape, or any other helps. Bibles will be checked for markings in the ready room. Should any markings, folded pages, or helps be found, the participant will be supplied with a clean Bible.**
