Ukraine

On a cool April night, the sound of voices lifted in worship swirled through the air. The rich tones invaded every crack and crevice of the ancient concert hall packed to the rafters with Ukrainians hungry for hope.

In this final concert of their fifth trip to the Ukraine, the Singing Men of Texas closed the evening filled with a sense of awe at what the Lord had done during their ten days in Ukraine. Every night they sang God's praise in English, but Ukrainian translations on the large screens gave each audience member an opportunity to understand the message of hope in Christ Jesus.

In each of the nine concerts, huge crowds listened raptly to the Gospel presented in music, in the preaching of evangelist Michael Gott, and in a message of encouragement from a local pastor.

The 2017 trip saw over 6,500 Ukrainians respond to the Gospel in some way. The Cooperative Program supports Texas Baptists Music and Worship, which makes ministries like the Singing Men of Texas possible.

Let's pray now for their ministry and for the people of Ukraine, that the seeds planted last April will continue to take root and bring about a great harvest.
