## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. HOW MANY COLLEGE CREDIT HOURS DO I NEED TO APPLY?**

You must be in at least your first semester of college after high school graduation. Some positions require completion of additional semesters.
- 2. WHAT DOES “TOTAL COST OF PROJECT” MEAN?**

This is what it costs to send a student missionary in this project. It includes transportation (to, from and on the field), housing, meals, insurance, shots, personal incidentals, visa, training materials, orientation and debriefing (it does not include the cost of a passport).
- 3. WHAT DOES “AMOUNT YOU RAISE” MEAN?**

This is the portion of the cost that you will raise if appointed to the project. The balance between this and the total cost of the project is raised by BSM (Baptist Student Ministry) groups across Texas. You will receive fundraising training when appointed.
- 4. WHAT IF I CANNOT ATTEND DISCOVERY DAY?**

Call the Go Now office now (817-277-4077).
- 5. CAN FORMER GO NOW MISSIONARIES APPLY?**

Yes! We have an updated application this year. If you served before, you will need to complete a new application. If you would like a copy of your old application emailed to you, contact Go Now.
- 6. CAN GRADUATING SENIORS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS APPLY?**

Yes! Students are eligible to apply for up to 6 months following graduation. Seminary and graduate students are welcome to apply.
- 7. WHAT IF I HAVE QUESTIONS?**

## APARTMENT SPORTS & ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR

**MISSION FOCUS:** Immigrants, Apartment Ministry, Women's Sports Ministry

**DATES:** May 25 - Aug. 3, 2020, Orientation May 22 - 24, 2020

Veteran Global Gates missionaries in Houston need your talents and skills to open doors for making relationships with Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists in apartment complexes for the purpose of sharing the Gospel. The Houston team is ready to market your skills in one or more of the following areas to reach immigrants: Aerobics trainer - Lead immigrant women in aerobic classes; Swimming trainer for kids - Offer private swimming lessons exclusively to immigrant children; Assistant Physician's Assistant - Travel with PA to clinics and apartments as she medically treats immigrant families; Teach Spoken English - Supplement ESL programs by offering immigrants a place to practice their English. Through aerobic classes for women, private swimming lessons for kids, teaching spoken English and assisting our team Physician's Assistant, you will create relational avenues for our team to fulfill the Great Commission among Houston's least evangelized people groups.

Come gain practical port ministry experience as you minister to the workers on the ships that come to Port Canaveral, FL. Most of the work will be done at our ministry center, but you may help drive and visit workers on cargo ships. Depending on your skills, the team will handle a variety of tasks at the ministry. This includes ministering to crew by leading worship, leading Bible studies, sharing one-on-one, and discipleship. You will also receive and distribute packages, greet visitors and help them sign in, help prepare lunch, and maintain the drink station with beverages and snacks. There is also the possibility of helping us develop social media, maintain the building and grounds and clean vehicles.

Use your acquired campus knowledge and connections to help strategic churches learn how to reach the college students in their neighborhood and on campuses near them. You will work in cooperation with the existing MNYBA team to equip, train, and send local church members to serve campus. You will be part of a ministry, in partnership with the MNYBA, to engage the culture of campuses in NYC (there are over 100) and connect churches to ministry opportunities through our social organization called The Commons. You will help be the face of this organization on campuses and in our churches. They would also provide an opportunity to minister and connect more deeply with students from the point of first contact. (College students relate best to other college students).

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Must be a Sophomore or above (in second year of college after high school graduation). Students who are outgoing, strong in their faith, and socially adept. Many conversations will be had where another student holds an opposite viewpoint from their own, the ability to navigate that conversation and use it as an opportunity to respectfully present the gospel is key!

Crossroads Church of Long Island hosts 4 weeks of sports and Bible camps (soccer, baseball, and basketball) during the summer. The camps are for children, first through sixth grade. You will help with these camps, which are held Monday-Thursday each week. You should enjoy the outdoors, exhibit a love for working with kids and have the ability to work with volunteers (students and adults) from mission teams who serve during the summer. You will have the responsibility to help prepare our facilities to host mission teams each week. You need to display a love for God and for reaching people in a mission field context, as you will also be involved in outreach projects throughout the summer including prayer walking, personal evangelism, and servant evangelism projects. You will have the opportunity to be involved in the local churches while they are here on the field, assisting with leadership, as needed.

## ELEVATE CHURCH PLANTING

**MISSION FOCUS:** Church Planting, Young Adults & Families

Come to the fastest growing area in Colorado to help in 2 church plants located between Longmont (north Denver) and the Fort Collins/Loveland area. These new churches focus on young professionals and young families. The church plants are relational in nature and do missional activity not merely to start a church, but to love their city! We are more interested in planting the Gospel into the lives of the people than seeing a church started. We utilize servant and relational evangelism, home Bible study fellowships and scouting. You need to be willing to build bridges with people of varying world-views and walks of life that are often far outside of the church culture. You will learn to identify spiritually open people by applying the "persons of peace" strategy in Luke 10:2b-11, learn how to ask common-ground questions to gain understanding by hearing the person's story and how to share God's story. The focus for our student interns is threefold: know God more, know yourself more, & know people (your field) more. We invest into you as you invest your time into the people here.

Like the outdoors and able to be highly active (okay with using a bike from time to time as transportation). Spanish is helpful, but not required.

Your first stop will be a joint orientation with other Nehemiah Teams, learning the skills needed to carry out your assignment as well as team building time. If you wish to share your faith through sports or want to learn how to share your faith through sports, this position is for you. You will be busy, you will travel, you will learn to work together as a team, you will sweat, you will be tired, but you will be blessed and have a summer you will long remember. You will serve at multiple churches in different states conducting sports camps and you will serve primarily as Sport Time Leader and Bible Study Facilitator. There will be a multitude of other things you will be engaged in throughout the day, as well. Be prepared to minister to students in Grades 1-6, have contact with several adults each week, and learn skills that can use into the future, like how to get along with people in difficult situations, how to organize an effective lesson plan and implement it and revise it as necessary. You will also learn how to communicate better by talking to kids who don't understand some of your big words. Plans can quickly change because of rain, more kids than you expected, the facility size is different than you expected, or because you may have to share your space unexpectedly with another Sport Time. Flexibility will be key!

Our focus is making disciples amongst the least reached people of the northwestern portion of Brazil. This team serves in both the large city of Manaus, as well as more rural communities. There is an emphasis on building relationships among healthy churches and encouraging them to leave the comfort of their walls to make disciples and plant churches where the gospel has not yet been heard. You will begin and end your summer at orientation and debriefing in Memphis, TN along with other students being sent to serve throughout the Americas.

## RESTORATIVE JUSTICE INTERN

**MISSION FOCUS:** Prison Ministry, Chaplaincy

As an intern your primary responsibility is to help the inmates and staff at the prison discover, develop, and duplicate their faith in Jesus Christ, fulfilling the role of Correctional Chaplain. The correctional chaplain has direct responsibilities for the operation of the chaplaincy programs within the institution. The chaplain intern position supports the institutional chaplaincy department within the normal range of chaplaincy services pertaining to provisions of worship opportunities, religious education programs, and a variety of personal counseling needs complying with all applicable rules, policies, and procedures related to security. You will also attend and participate in the youth/collegiate ministry of FBC Bratt, under the supervision of the Pastor and Student Pastor. Specific activities include preaching and sharing your testimony, teaching youth and college Sunday School classes, participating in youth and college outreach programs, and teaching in Vacation Bible School.

Resolved For Provo is an evangelistic ministry to the least reached metro area in North America: Provo/Orem, UT. Our city is 0.5% born-again. There are 75,000 college students in our metro with 99.85% being lost. One of the main outreach events that we do each month is called Intersect. Intersect is an interfaith dialogue event.
