

**Texas Baptist Missions Foundation** partners with individuals and families to support creative and innovative ministries in Texas. Since 2005, the BGCT has helped begin over **950** new churches among **25** different ethnic groups, averaging **136** professions of faith per church. The convention has maintained a 95% **success** rate for new church starts, intentionally partnering with each church over a five year period to reach a healthy level of autonomy and sustainability. The average contribution needed for a new church start is \$28,000, but there are many locations in Texas where a contribution of just \$2,500 can start a new church.



Combining the capabilities of **technology** and the power of **prayer**, Texas Baptists are championing a powerful online tool that allows churches and their members to access public information about their community all in **one** place, like an online Yellow Pages. This information enables churches to pray for every home in their community and, eventually, our entire state by name, inviting the Spirit to transform our Texas communities in a personal way. In the event of a natural disaster, Texas Baptists are ready to respond immediately to any location in the world. *Thousands* of volunteers have been mobilized over the years to help meet the needs of affected communities, including distributing food, water, supplies, rebuilding homes and churches. The program also recognizes the need for long-term recovery in many of these communities even after initial support is over. Texas Baptists need to be ready to respond to any disaster at any time, especially because of the mission opportunities disaster recovery provides.



God is working in tremendous ways on our nation's university campuses and especially in Texas through our **Baptist Student Ministries.** However, many BSM buildings need to be remodeled or replaced, which will **enable** Baptist students to reach more students. There are also needs to develop new programs and **send** students on summer and semester missions.



The Missions Foundation partners with many other ministries that promise to introduce people to Christ throughout our state. Cowboy churches are reaching and baptizing people involved in the Western Heritage movement in record numbers, and more of these churches need to be started. In addition, the Hispanic **Education Initiative** strives to provide Hispanic students with scholarship incentives and academic resources to excel in their early educational years. This ministry seeks to raise **\$1,000** scholarships for deserving students who plan to attend a Texas Baptist university. The Texas Baptist Hunger Offering is also meeting the needs of communities by partnering with local food banks and ministries to stop the cycle of poverty at its source. By providing for people's physical needs, opportunities arise to then meet people's spiritual needs.
